Mentors must be at least 21 years of age and possess a current year NJ hunting license for the type of hunting (firearm or bow) they will be doing with the Apprentice Hunter. 2. Mentors must obtain and possess written permission from the parent or guardian of a minor (under 18) Apprentice Hunter. 3. Mentors cannot supervise more than one Apprentice Hunter at a time in the field.
