There is no specific rule under the Companies Act, 2013 or anywhere else under other laws, as to who is an appropriate authority to sign a certified copy of the board resolutions. A true copy of any board resolution or the extract of the minutes is generally considered acceptable, if it is signed either by the Managing Director or by any two Directors jointly or by the Company Secretary of the ...

Board resolutions can show whether directors are fulfilling their duties to the business. For instance, section 156(1)(a) of the Companies Act states that directors are required to disclose their interest in transactions with the company at a directors' meeting.

The Board Resolution has to be invariably signed by the person who presided over the board meeting and has to be countersigned by another Director/Company Secretary and must be recorded in the Minutes Book. Board resolutions are passed by a simple majority (i.e. more than 50%), unless otherwise stated in the company constitution. Examples of decisions where the company can pass a board resolution, in accordance with the Companies Act: Opening a corporate bank account and authorising employees for transactions;

Attending directors' meetings. ... All eligible directors must either sign copies of the written resolution, or otherwise agree to it in writing.
